C10.51.1 A list for everything.

Instead of having split views in Certificates, all information is now gathered in one list, making it easier to administer your company's certificates.

C10.51.2 Increased performance.

We are reducing the time needed to administer certificates in Comaea. You will notice a big difference in loading times and refresh times for simple tasks and navigating through comaea.

C10.51.3 Ability to mass edit / add certificates

To facilitate the preparation of certificates, it is now possible to connect several employees who have completed one and the same training at the same time. What you previously did for one employee before, you can do for several at the same time.

C10.51.4 Prepare certificates for new employees.

One function that many of our customers have lacked is the ability to set up and prepare which certificates and training an employee should have, but which has not yet been completed. It is now possible to create a certificate with a target level before the course / certification occurs; for example, a certificate a new employee must complete. This will help facilitate the planning of future development / courses.

C10.51.5 Ability to have several levels on a certificate.

Much like competencies, you can now have more than one level of a certificate. This reduces the number of certificates required to be created and enables you to use several steps of development in one certification, with the ability to set target levels for roles. You can now plan in advance which certificates a new employee needs to perform their professional role or use it to mark which level the employee should be at if a certificate / development has several levels.

C10.51.6 Mark which certificates the employee is active in.

You now have an "Active" status for a certification to show if the certificate is actively used in the employee's professional role. Can thus be used to distinguish whether an employee has a valid certificate and that certificate is relevant or not for her current professional role. In addition this helps with historical certification, where one certificate has been replaced by another and is thus no longer "active", but you need to see who has had it.

NOTE: In connection with the introduction of the current level and target level of certificates, comaea will update all your certificates so that they receive correct data in connection with the release.
